## Cancellation Policy

- **Cancellation** until 23<sup>th</sup> **March 2022**, TUL will refund **all** payments.
- **Cancellation** between 23<sup>th</sup> **March 2022** and 24<sup>th</sup> **May 2022**, TUL will refund **90%** of the deposited prepayment.
- **Cancellation** between 25<sup>th</sup> **May 2022** and 25<sup>th</sup> **June 2022**, **50%** of the whole to be paid amount will be refunded by TUL.
- **Last minute cancellation** between 26<sup>th</sup> **June 2022** and 24<sup>th</sup> **July 2022**, **20%** of the whole to be paid amount will be refunded by TUL.
  
- **Championship's cancellation:**  
We must inform that TUL will reserve the right of cancellation, if there are not at least 3 member unions and at least 16 players preliminary registered at **23<sup>th</sup> March 2022**. In that case TUL will refund **all** payments.

Based on the provisional registration of players it will be decided if the Chess championships will be cancelled. This decision will be taken directly after the **23<sup>th</sup> of March 2022 (preliminary registration deadline)** at the latest.

## A. There will be three chess events:

### 1. Individual Rapid Championship (IRC)

- a. The Championship will be played only if there are at least 16 players from at least 3 different countries.
- b. Each CSIT member or non-member organization is entitled to send as many players as possible.
- c. All the players should have FIDE (World Chess Federation) ID Number.
- d. Players with a FIDE **Rapid** Rating (as per January 1<sup>st</sup> of the championship year) of more than 2350 cannot take part in the championship.
- e. The championship will be held according to the Swiss System with nine rounds (subject to changes depending on the number of participants and the number of days available for the tournament). No more than four games will be played within 24 hours.
- f. The rate of play will be 25 minutes for the whole game plus 10 seconds for each move.
- a. Tie Breaks: Buchholz cut-1, results among the relevant players, number of victories, number of Blacks.
- g. Prizes: Medals for the first three winning players, the most surprising player and the best players among the seniors (55+) women and unrated. Diplomas of participation for all players, non-playing captains and arbiters.

### 2. Individual Blitz Championship (IBC)

- a. The participation is open to all players (including officials, arbiters etc.) who have FIDE (World Chess Federation) ID Number.
- b. Players with a FIDE **Blitz** Rating (as per January 1<sup>st</sup> of the championship year) of more than 2350 cannot take part in the championship.
- c. The championship will be held according to the Swiss System with 9 rounds.
- d. The rate of play will be 5 minutes for each player for the whole game + 3 seconds per each move.
- e. Tie Breaks: Buchholz cut-1, results among the relevant players, number of victories, number of Blacks.
- f. Prizes: Medals for the first three winning players and the most surprising player.

### 3. Simultaneous Exhibition (SE)



- a. The participation is open to all players (including officials, arbiters etc.) who have FIDE (World Chess Federation) ID Number.
- b. Players with a FIDE **Standard** Rating (as per January 1st of the championship year) of more than 2000 cannot take part in this event.
- c. The player who will play against the participants will be chosen by the organizers as long as he holds the title of International Chess Grandmaster.
- d. Prizes: Medals for those who will defeat the Grandmaster (gold) or end with him in a draw (silver) or hold out against him for the longest time (bronze).

## B. FAIR PLAY

CSIT championships are organized according the principals of Fair Play. During CSIT Championships athletes, persons and teams can be awarded for acts of Fair Play. Fair Play regulations can be found in the CSIT Technical Commissions and Championships General Regulations edition 2016 and later, Chapter 5.

Besides this CSIT Chess Championships shall respect the principles of Fair Play in Chess as outlined by the Anti Cheating Guidelines of FIDE (the World Chess Federation) –
